Christmas in the Valley Parade

We are pleased to be the sponsor of the **21st Annual Valley Christmas Parade** on **Saturday, December 9th, 2017**. Below is the parade entry form, general parade information and a list of parade rules. Please fill out and return the entry form as soon as possible to the address at the bottom.

General Parade Information and Rules

The Parade will start at LBC Middle School at 3PM on **December 9, 2017**. Parade line up will begin at 1 PM. If you need additional time to prepare your parade entry for judging, you can arrive earlier than 1 PM. When you arrive at LBC Middle School, report to a check-in station. Parade coordinators (they'll be the ones in the golf carts) can assist you in checking in and locating your spot in the parade line-up. The parade will begin promptly at 3 PM, so the earlier you arrive, the better.

- **ONLY 1 designated Santa Claus will be in the parade, being the finale and representing the Midland Valley Chamber of Commerce**
- **All parade entries are to have a Christmas theme/decorations.**
- Personal or commercial pick-up trucks can be in the parade if they are carrying groups such as cheerleaders, football teams, families, business employees, church groups, etc. These should also be decorated accordingly.
- Racecars and other non-street legal vehicles **MUST be carried on a trailer and/or towed.**
- Commercial vehicles can be in the parade if they are being used as a float, towing vehicles OR they are decorated with a Christmas theme.
- You are responsible for your signs, banners, decorations, etc.
- Walking groups should be in uniforms or Christmas outfits. This is not a requirement, but it encouraged.
- The parade committee reserves the right to disallow an entry that is not suitable for a Christmas parade.
- Motorcycles and four wheelers are **prohibited**.
